

# Product Price Ex Widget

## Widget Use

Renders the ex-tax price on the product detail page when the [Tax Toggle](#) is in use. Pair this widget with the [Product Price Inc widget](#) on the Product Detail template.

## Widget Options

Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	We recommend this field be updated so the widget's purpose is clear at a glance from the template page.	All
Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>The <a href="#">layering technology</a> allows for the content to be shown to specific audiences.</p> <p>This is handy if the content is only valid for a certain type of user, or if the same widget is required for more than one audience, but different configuration is needed.</p> <p>The widget can be added to the zone more than once and the layer feature can determine which audience can see each widget.</p>	All

GST Text	Identifies whether the price displayed is inclusive or exclusive of GST (dependant on the customer). The {0} acts as a placeholder for the 'inc' or 'ex' text.	Default is: {0} GST	3.88
Attributed Product Price Display	Determines the price shown for master products appearing in the list. Select from: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Default Functionality</li> <li>• Don't Show</li> <li>• Price From Default</li> <li>• Price From First</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Default Functionality - the nett price for one is displayed. This value is derived from the master code.</li> <li>• Don't Show - no price is displayed for master products - the user must select attributes in order to view pricing.</li> <li>• Price From Default - the price for the option marked as 'Default' in Attribute Maintenance is displayed.</li> <li>• Price From First - the price for the first attribute option in the list is displayed.</li> </ul>	3.88
Strip Zero Decimal Amounts	When the price is an even dollar amount, the cents are stripped from the display. (For example, \$147.00 would be displayed as \$147)	Default is: unticked  Tick to enable	3.88

## Implementation Notes

- To avoid duplication of price display, tick the 'Hide Pricing?' flag on the Product Purchase Details widget (if you are using it) when this widget is in use.
- For earlier versions of CSS, you may wish to add a class of 'detailed price'. This will style the content in the same way as the Product Purchase Details widget.

## Other Widgets

- [Order Payment Links Form Widget](#) — Renders an order details stepper with an order form that can be automatically populated with query strings, and/or manually entered by the user. The form doesn't validate the order details are accurate in order to stay both secure and accessible to unauthenticated users.
- [Magic Link Authentication Message Widget](#) — Renders the Magic Link authentication message.
- [CUSTOM\\_Side by Side Content Tiles Widget](#) — Renders two side by side content tiles in a zone with widget options for selecting or adding background colour, image, text and link/button positioning.
- [Stock Dialog Widget](#) — Displays the Stock to Receive Detail dialog window.
- [Stock to Receive Widget](#) — Displays the Stock to Receive page.
- [Stock Levels Widget](#) — Displays Stock Levels page.
- [Order Declined Pending 3rd Party Installment Msg Widget](#) — Renders the message body for the email sent when the user selects to sign up and pay with a Buy Now Pay Later provider but approval is subject to further checks.
- [Order Field Static Widget](#) — Renders an additional order field in email templates.
- [Online Quote Validation Widget](#) — Renders the appropriate message to the user after the current status of an online quote accessed via an email link is validated.
- [Header Level Cost Centre Widget](#) — Renders the cost centre input field on the order header in the shopping cart.
- [Openpay Summary Widget](#) — Renders Openpay marketing information for a product on the product detail page. Use this widget instead of the [Product Purchase Details widget](#) if you want to customise tagline placement on the template.
- [Order Line Availability - Click and Collect Widget](#) — Displays product availability and delivery methods at the order line level in dynamic scenarios such as the cart when Click & Collect is enabled.
- [Account Activation Email Content Widget](#) — Renders the message content in the Invitation to Register an Account email.
- [Order Template Cost Centre Widget](#) — Renders the cost centre input field on each product line in an order template.
- [BPAY Account Payment Detail Widget](#) — Renders BPAY payment information in the body of the BPAY Account Payment email. This email is sent to users who pay invoices or pay down their account balance using BPAY.
