

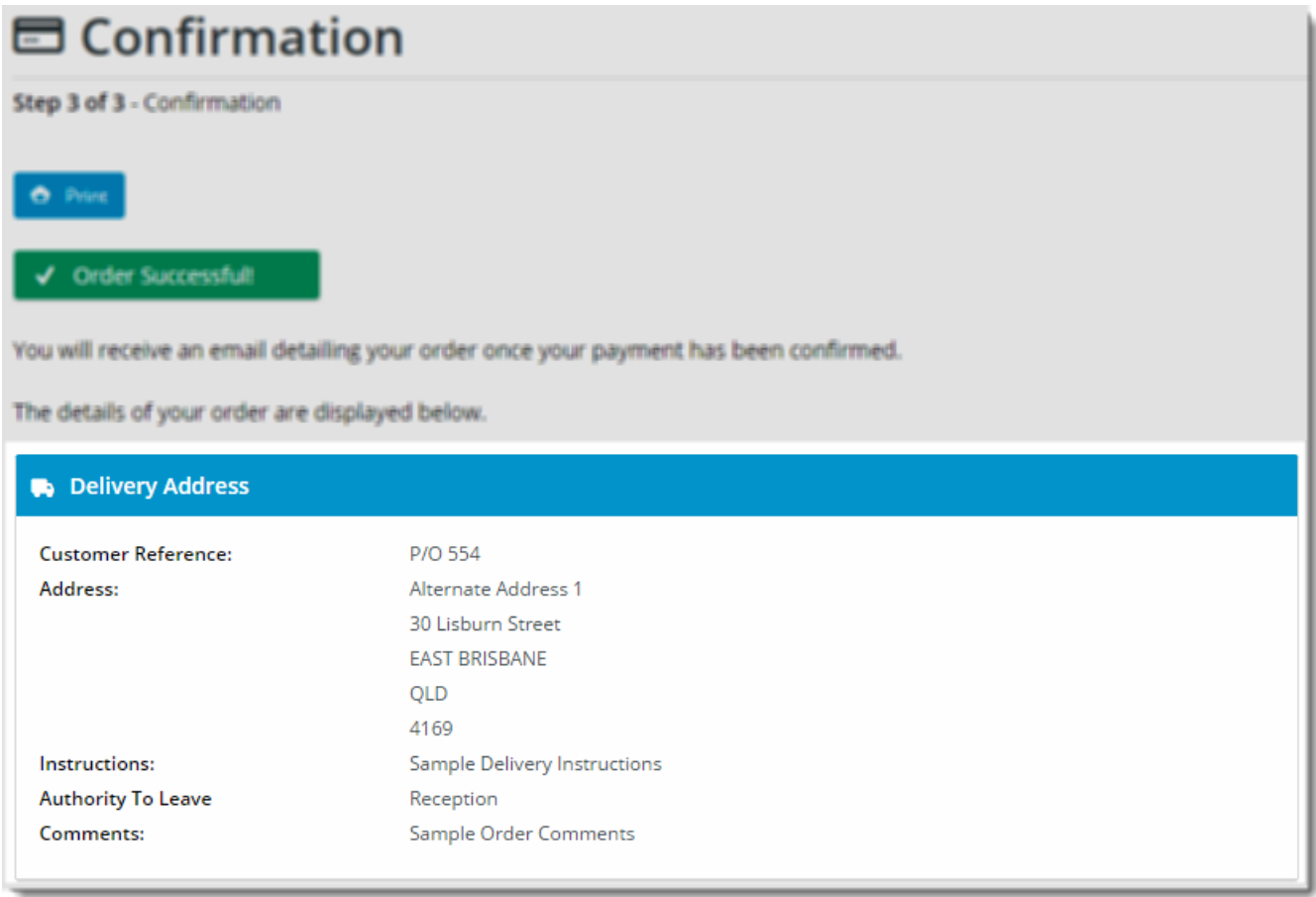
Order Confirmation Address B2B Widget

Displays the B2B user's address and delivery information on the Order Confirmation page.

Widget Options

Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	We recommended this field be updated so the widget's purpose is clear at a glance from the template page.	All

Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>The layering technology allows for the content to be shown to specific audiences.</p> <p>This is handy if the content is only valid for a certain type of user, or if the same widget is required for more than one audience, but different configuration is needed.</p> <p>The widget can be added to the zone more than once and the layer feature can determine which audience can see each widget.</p>	All
Delivery Details Heading	The heading text displayed at the top of the widget for the delivery address section.	Default is: Delivery Address	All
Delivery Details Heading Icon	The icon displayed to the left of the Delivery heading text.	<p>Default is: cv-ico-general-truck</p> <p>Select via drop-down</p>	All
Pickup Details Heading	The heading text displayed at the top of the widget for the pickup address section.	Default is: Pickup Details	All
Pickup Details Heading Icon	The icon displayed to the left of the Pickup heading text.	Default is: cv-ico-general-store	All
Customer Reference Prompt	The label for the order reference field.	Default is: Customer Reference	All
Address Prompt	The label for the address fields.	Default is: Address	All
Delivery Instructions Prompt	The label for the delivery instructions field.	Default is: Delivery Instructions	All
Pickup Instructions Prompt	The label for the pickup instructions field.	Default is: Pickup Instructions	All
Order Comments Prompt	The label for the order comments field.	Default is: Order Comments	All
Attention To Prompt	The label for the attention to field.	Default is: Attention To	All
Copy Order Confirmation Prompt	The label for the CC field.	Default is: Copy Order Confirmation	All
Show Authority To Leave?	Determines whether the authority to leave field is displayed in the output.	<p>Default is: unticked</p> <p>Tick to enable</p>	3.81
Authority To Leave Prompt	The label for the authority to leave field.	Default is: Authority To Leave	3.81
Authority To Leave Format	The format in which authority to leave information is displayed in the output.	<p>Default is: Authority To Leave {0}</p> <p>The '{0}' is the placeholder for the selected drop-down value</p>	3.81

Other Widgets

- [Order Payment Links Form Widget](#) — Renders an order details stepper with an order form that can be automatically populated with query strings, and/or manually entered by the user. The form doesn't validate the order details are accurate in order to stay both secure and accessible to unauthenticated users.
- [Magic Link Authentication Message Widget](#) — Renders the Magic Link authentication message.
- [CUSTOM_Side by Side Content Tiles Widget](#) — Renders two side by side content tiles in a zone with widget options for selecting or adding background colour, image, text and link/button positioning.
- [Stock Dialog Widget](#) — Displays the Stock to Receive Detail dialog window.
- [Stock to Receive Widget](#) — Displays the Stock to Receive page.
- [Stock Levels Widget](#) — Displays Stock Levels page.
- [Order Declined Pending 3rd Party Installment Msg Widget](#) — Renders the message body for the email sent when the user selects to sign up and pay with a Buy Now Pay Later provider but approval is subject to further checks.
- [Order Field Static Widget](#) — Renders an additional order field in email templates.
- [Online Quote Validation Widget](#) — Renders the appropriate message to the user after the current status of an online quote accessed via an email link is validated.
- [Header Level Cost Centre Widget](#) — Renders the cost centre input field on the order header in the shopping cart.
- [Openpay Summary Widget](#) — Renders Openpay marketing information for a product on the product detail page. Use this widget instead of the [Product Purchase Details widget](#) if you want to customise tagline placement on the template.
- [Order Line Availability - Click and Collect Widget](#) — Displays product availability and delivery methods at the order line level in dynamic scenarios such as the cart when Click & Collect is enabled.
- [Account Activation Email Content Widget](#) — Renders the message content in the Invitation to Register an Account email.
- [Order Template Cost Centre Widget](#) — Renders the cost centre input field on each product line in an order template.

- [BPAY Account Payment Detail Widget](#) — Renders BPAY payment information in the body of the BPAY Account Payment email. This email is sent to users who pay invoices or pay down their account balance using BPAY.
