We have updated the **Last Edited** column in the Custom Widget list with the username of the person who made the most recent changes to the widget.

Step-by-step guide

1. In the CMS, navigate to **Advanced Content Custom Widgets**.
2. The system will display the custom widgets screen.
3. In the **Last Edited** column we display the user name of the person who last edited the widget and on which date the change was made.
